### XIII. Whatever my lot



#### A. There are two things to notice

1. There are still very large areas of land that still need to be taken over.

2. Be sure to allocate this land to Israel for an inheritance, as I have instructed you.

#### B. Joshua had two jobs

1. Take the children across the Jordan and fight the Canaanites and get control of the land

2. Divide this land as an inheritance to the tribes of Israel

#### C. God's intention for His people

1. The reason this is important for us to see is that God's people haven't really changed that much

2. Why is it that God's people settle for such a small inheritance?

3. God did not want Joshua to stop because he had grown old

4. God does not want His people to go into a maintenance mode!

2. Frame the mission God is giving

3. Claim the inheritance God has given you.
