SUBJECT: CHRISTOLOGY TOPIC: THE EMPTY TOMB

## 1. Read Matt. 27:62-28:8

- 2. The empty tomb of Jesus relates to the most important event in the entire history of mankind.
  - (1) That the dead can be brought back to life again, is indeed incredible. That's incredible!
  - (2) Exactly what happened just under 2000 years ago. Jesus was put to death, buried and on the third day He came out of His tomb. **Rev. 1:17-18.**
  - (3) That is the gospel message of Jesus Christ. The salvation of all mankind rests solidly on this historical fact. **I Cor. 15:17**;
  - (4) The preaching of the apostles was the death, burial and empty tomb of Jesus.

- 3. Why is the empty tomb of Jesus so critical to the Christian religion and mankind in general?

## DISCUSSION.

- The empty tomb gives credibility to the claims Jesus made about Himself. Matt. 16:13;
  Peter and the apostles Mark 14:61-62.
  - (1) He is God, John 1:1-2;
  - (2) He is God our Savior, Titus 2:11-14

- (3) He stands between us and God; To reach God we must go through Him, I Tim. 2:5
- (4) He is the only right way, truth and life, John 14:6
- (5) He gives eternal life John 10:10, 27-28; I John 5:11
- 2. The empty tomb establishes our accountability to God Acts 17:30, 31.
  - (1) The Supreme Court of God 2 Cor. 5:10
  - (2) Rom. 2:6-7
- 3. The empty tomb means that Jesus has defeated death and the Devil. I Cor. 15:54-58
  - (1) We too can be victorious over life. Our victory is our faith in Jesus. I John 5:4
  - (2) We can be victorious over death and the Devil, Rom. 8:37-39
- 4. The empty tomb means that your tomb will also be empty. Rev. 20:12-13
  - (1) Jesus is the resurrection and the life, John 11:25
  - (2) At His death, the cemeteries became vacant, Matt. 27:50-53
- 5. The empty tomb means that the hope we have is real. I Pet. 1:3;
  - (1) The despair of Good Friday, leads to the joy of Easter, Luke 24:18-21
  - (2) You never need to despair. Jairus' daughter. Mark 5:22, 39-42
  - (3) Jesus is the God of comfort, 2 Cor. 1:3-4, 9.
