  - Paul told us in Eph. 3.:20

- We need to know that nothing lies outside the reach of prayer except what lies outside the will of God
- And things are going to stay the way they are until we let God out of the box
- E. We can not do supernatural work through natural power... may God forgive us for trying to

## - Hadden Robinson said that the work is prayer (Because it is God that accomplishes spiritual victory)

#### 1. Moses... Joshua... Nehemiah...

- **2**. Our first priority is to pray for God to become involved, not our last.
- **3.** Acts **4** (Shook the house)
- 4. We need God to shake the house in our life! In the church! in this lost world!
